One tenth is in the Greenland Ice Sheet. This means 20% of the world's freshwater is right here, inside an ice sheet covering a staggering 1.71 million sq km.

SUMMER TEMPERATURES

Arctic temperatures in summer range from around 3°-12°C (37°- 54°F). The weather can change rapidly, with sudden shifts in temperature, wind and visibility.

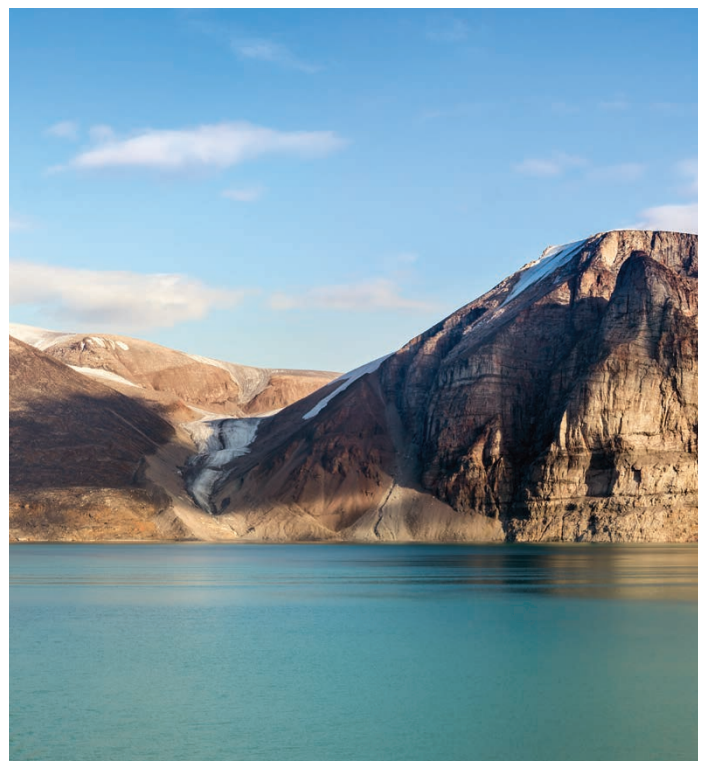

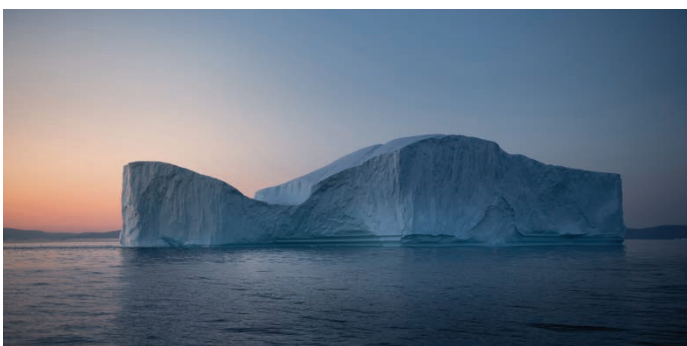

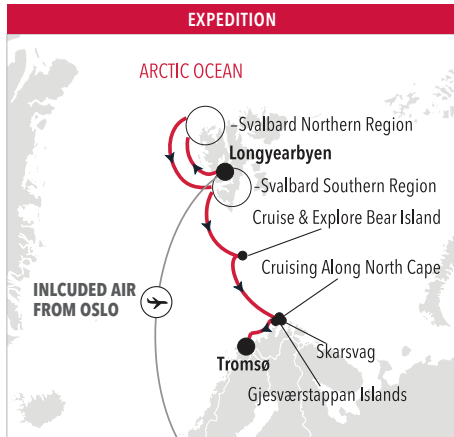

ANDREW WEBB – Wildlife Guide

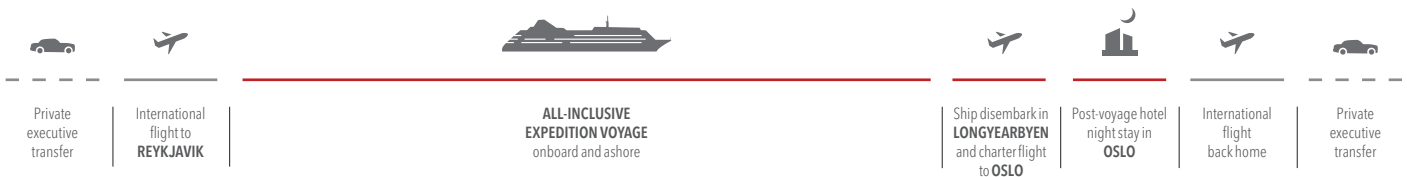

ALEX (SASHA) FREL – Historian

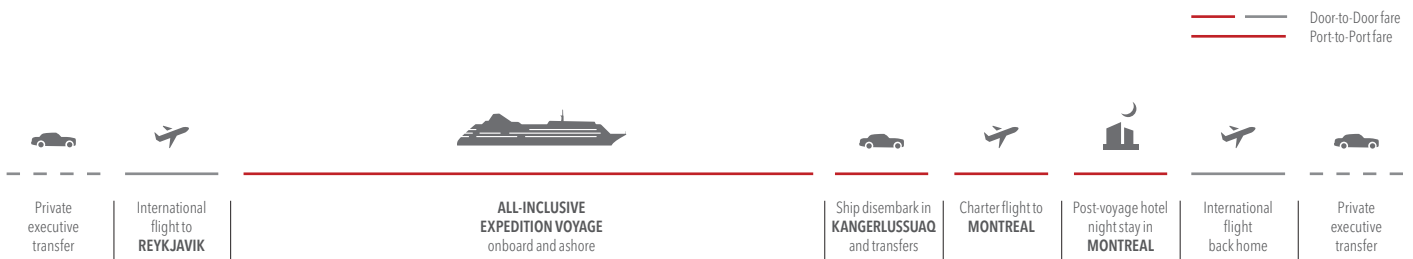

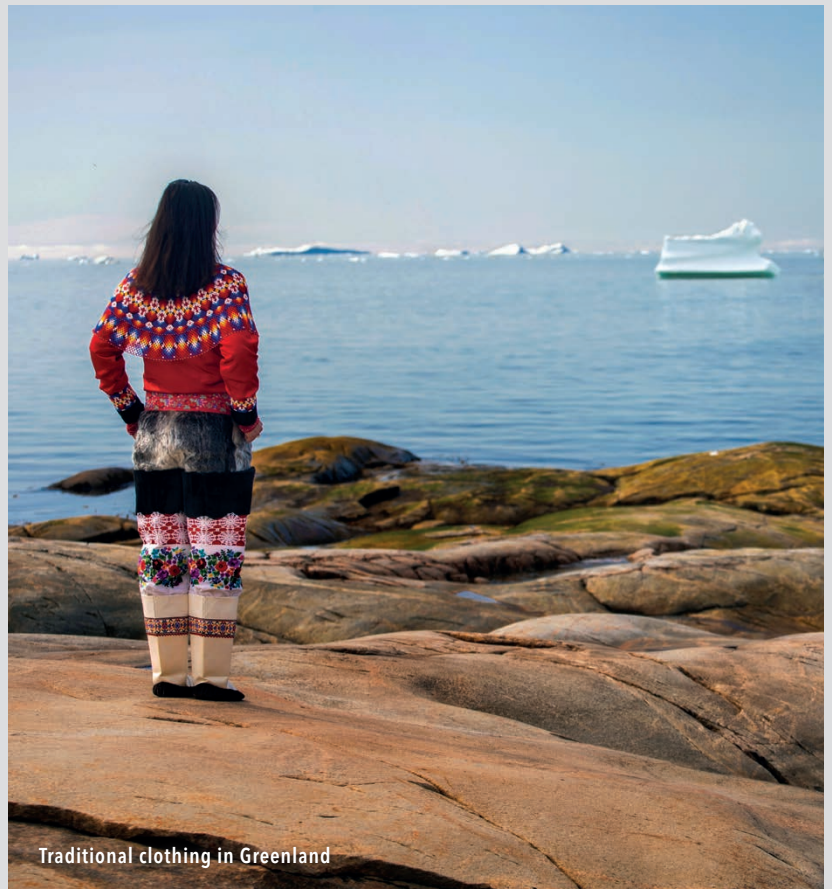

Although sightings of polar bears can't be guaranteed, an unforgettable experience is certain.
